FINANCE & HR MANAGER:

Discussed the benefits of enforcing Policy # 1065 - Use of Traffic Control Devices for Community Events, and the importance of adhering to the policy.

ROAD FOREMAN:

MACDOUGALL -

The triple seal projects are completed with only the fog seal remaining. Chip sealing was also done for the Village of Baldwin. Everything ran very smoothly this year.

Crews are currently working to reconstruct spillways on S. Branch Road in Sweetwater Township.

96th Street in Lake Township has been patched as needed due to ongoing logging operations.

DAILEY -

The second brine application has been progressing over the last two weeks and is on budget.

Beavers continue to be a nuisance on 10 Mile Road in Dover Township.

LEUSBY -

Repairs to an underground electrical conduit at the Chase Brine Facility have been completed. Extending the concrete pad will need to be done once brining is complete.

Discussed the need for diagnostic software to repair trucks and equipment. A demonstration by JPRO Diagnostics went very well, but the quote will need to be updated to accommodate a variety of wiring adaptors to match all our equipment.

Announced that mechanic Tony Hill has presented his resignation to be effective September 5, 2024.
