FINANCE & HR MANAGER:

Lake Osceola State Bank can finance the new extended reach loader and the gravel crusher with Installment Purchase Agreements that can be tailored to fit. Terms will be \$50,000.00 down, with five annual payments.

MANAGER:

Wolf Lake Drain Improvement Project- Bonds have been signed. Prein & Newhoff has the contractor moving in equipment starting 6-22-2023. Bids will need to be sought for future maintenance of the drain.

Paving of 56th St from 60th St to Mac Rd is complete.

Application of BioSeal to 40th St between Deer Lake Rd and Lakola Rd will happen 6-28-2023.

Application of Permazyme to 32nd St between Peacock Trail and Jenks Rd will happen as soon as the preparation work is complete.

Eden Township's local roads project preparation is complete and chip sealing will begin soon.
