

RESOLUTION

Requesting Local Bridge Funding for Peacock Road Bridge over the Little Manistee River (STR 5293)

At the regular meeting of the Lake County Board of Road Commissioners held at the Road Commission office, Baldwin, Michigan, on March 24, 2023.

Present: Haslock and Runnels

The following resolution was offered by Runnels and supported by Haslock:

WHEREAS: the Lake County Board of Road Commissioners is responsible for and deeply interested in the mobility and safety of the people traveling in Lake County, and

WHEREAS, the Peacock Road Bridge over the Little Manistee River in Lake County is in serious condition, and

WHEREAS, all bridges are important structures in our county Road System; and

WHEREAS, the critical aspect of the Peacock Road Bridge over the Little Manistee River is its poor structural condition, and is in severe need of complete replacement, and

WHEREAS, it is not possible, financially, for the Lake County Board of Road Commissioners to replace this structure without Federal and State Funds; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Board of Road Commissioners has reviewed the attached application for Local Bridge Monies, and

WHEREAS, Peacock Road Bridge is the only public access to many properties for fire, school, and emergency services, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lake County Board of Road Commissioners hereby actively seeks participation through the Local Bridge Program in the replacement of the Peacock Road Bridge over the Little Manistee River and directs the Manager to submit a request for funding this project to MDOT on behalf of the Lake County Board of Road Commissioners for replacement of this bridge;
